Thanks to Eric Bueneman, Jeff Kitsko, and Jim Thomas for information appearing elsewhere in this column.

The WSTE transmitter at Aguada, Puerto Rico is the 3<sup>rd</sup> transmitter of a four-transmitter distributed transmission system. It may soon be the 3<sup>rd</sup> of a five-transmitter system, as the station proposes to add another transmitter at Sabana Grande. This new site is near (but not on) the WORA-TV Mayaguez tower.

Two new transmitters have been approved for CKVR-DT in southern Ontario. I've picked what I think is the best-known served community for each transmitter, strictly for space reasons. Canada doesn't have the same concept of "city of license" that exists in the U.S.; the channel 35 transmitter is expected to cover Hamilton, Burlington and Oakville. Channel 42 is to cover Fonthill, Fort Erie, Niagara Falls, St. Catharines and Welland.

For some reason, the callsign CHCJ-TV has been assigned to the Hamilton transmitter. Why is beyond me. The Niagara Falls transmitter is not yet in the database; the CKVR-DT-1 callsign is assumed.

The transmitters are not really intended to provide over-the-air service to these areas. Rather, they are intended to establish "simultaneous substitution" protection.

Under Canadian rules, if a cable operator carries both a local Canadian station and a U.S. station, and both stations air the same program at the same time, the cable operator must substitute the Canadian station's signal for the U.S. station's. For the Canadian station to be considered "local", it must have an over-the-air signal in the cable community.

"Simsubbing" can be quite valuable to the Canadian station. Viewers may be used to watching the U.S.-based station, but during popular simultaneous programs they'll see advertising sold by the Canadian outlet.

(Another way of looking at it is... that the Canadian station paid good money for the rights to air popular U.S. programs in their



Canadian coverage area. The station shouldn't have to compete with a U.S. station that didn't pay for those Canadian rights.)

The timing of the decision may not have been the best(grin). Simsubbing is at its most controversial during the Super Bowl. There is, as always, considerable talk about unusual commercials which will air during this game. However, most Canadian viewers will never see them. They must be "simsubbed" with Canadian spots.

(in practice, I'm sure most Canadian viewers who want to see the Super Bowl spots will find them on the advertisers' website...)

The deleted Canadian stations have been off since last August. Three operated above channel 51. (and had to move to lower channels or be deleted) One operates in a "mandatory market". (and had to convert to digital or be deleted) Several relayed analog stations' off-air signals and weren't converted to receive their primaries' new digital signals.

CJLN-TV's transmitter failed and is not considered repairable. The two stations in Exshaw, Alberta were used primarily to deliver CBRT's signal from the main transmitter in Calgary to relay CBRT-13 in Harvie Heights. CBRT-13 is now fed by satellite, so the Exshaw relayers are no longer necessary.

K38LE-D in Iowa has been bumped from their channel by WEAU-TV Eau Claire, Wis.. WEAU had been operating on channel 13 (their old analog channel) until their tower collapsed last year. The tower has been rebuilt – but when they activated the new tower, they also moved to channel 38.

WEAU also serves La Crosse – where K38LE puts in a significant signal. Obviously, interference to WEAU turned out to be a problem. K38LE has already filed for permission to move to channel 39, with no other changes in facilities. They have also filed for special temporary authority to implement the move before the normal approval process is complete.

The FCC has denied a creative proposal to get an additional DTV subchannel on cable.

Must-carry rules allow a full-power digital TV station to require local cable systems to carry one of their program streams. The station may select which stream is entitled to carriage. However, if the station broadcasts more than one stream, only one is required to be carried.

(in many cases, stations negotiate with cable

to obtain carriage for additional streams. These agreements are business contracts, not enforced by the FCC.)

ION (formerly known as "Pax" and licensee of most TV stations with the combination "PX" in their callsigns) proposed to split their licenses. They proposed to license a second station on each of their channels, and assign that license to a firm called "Urban Television LLC". The existing ION station and the new Urban station on each channel would share time, with ION using the channel part of the day and Urban using it the rest of the day.

This kind of thing has happened in the past. Growing up in Milwaukee, I remember occasionally DXing two stations sharing channel 10 in Lansing, Michigan. Michigan State University's station WMSB broadcast educational programs during the day; commercial station WILX-TV broadcast NBC and local programs in the afternoon and at night. A new timesharing situation is likely to develop in Sacramento, California in the next year or two, as two non-commercial licensees were found equally qualified, and both will receive licenses to operate on channel 43 there.

What's different in the ION case is the length of each time slot. In the WMSB/WILX case, WMSB used the channel continuously for several hours; it then signed off for the day, allowing WILX to use it continuously for the rest of the night. In ION's case, each station would operate for **a few milliseconds**. It would transmit one of ION's video packets, then one of Urban's audio packets, then one of Urban's video packets, then an Urban metadata packet, then an ION metadata packet, etc., etc.....

And to some degree, the FCC has on its own motion proposed doing just this. A station operating above channel 37 would give up its own channel and would share time on the transmitter of some other station operating below 37. Both stations would be entitled to a slot on cable/satellite; each would be individually responsible for what airs on their subchannel.

But in ION's case, the Commission isn't buying it. They labeled the scheme as "...a division of spectrum...", not a division of time - - and denied the license assignment.

The new KJLA permit is for a Digital Replacement Translator on Mt. Wilson, Los Angeles. It will relay the main transmitter licensed to Ventura, on the same channel.

**NEWS ITEM: *Two FMs Must Videotape RFR Workshop for FCC*** - In a case involving RFR levels at two FM stations in Hawaii, the FCC has decided to use short-term license renewals as an enforcement tool. The Media Bureau has granted limited 12-month license renewals and required that the owner implement a radiofrequency radiation training program — and send a video of the workshop to the FCC. Visionary Related Entertainment owns KNUQ in Paauilo and KAOI in Wailuku. The case resulted from complaints by a local arboretum and one of its employees, who objected to license renewals. (As with many FCC cases, this played out over several years; the objections were filed in January 2006, and the case dates at least back to 2004.) FCC rules set maximum permissible exposure levels of human exposure to RFR, and separate MPE limits for areas of “occupational/controlled” exposure and areas for “general population/uncontrolled” exposure. Stations can demonstrate compliance by restricting public access in areas where RFR exceeds public MPE limits. At both stations, after a lot of back-and-forth involving fencing, signage and antenna height, Visionary eventually asked for permission to move its transmitter sites. It received program test authority to do so; and the FCC now considers both KAOI and KNUQ to be in compliance. However, the problems found earlier caused the FCC staff to decide: “Visionary’s conduct has fallen far short of the standard of compliance with the act and the rules that would warrant routine license renewal.” It said the violations had been “serious” and that they constituted a pattern of abuse over a period of years at each station. “We believe that additional measures are necessary in order to ensure that the stations are operated in compliance with the act and the rules in the future,” so it granted short, 12-month renewal applications, adding that it has used this approach in other cases in the past.

“This limited renewal period will afford the commission an opportunity to review the stations’ compliance with the act and the rules and to take whatever corrective actions, if any, that may be warranted at that time.” It also required the company to implement a training program on RFR compliance for employees, agents and contractors. Visionary must videotape its workshop, use it to train staff and send a copy to the FCC. The FCC emphasized in a footnote that “places great emphasis on licensees’ compliance with safety and health regulations.”

**NEWS ITEM: *from Australia, a Look at What Radio Looks like*** - Australian radio sounds different, and looks different, too. So says radio observer and “futurist” James Cridland, who was in the country recently driving from Brisbane to Melbourne. He points readers to a slideshow on Flickr showing the visuals. “Listen on DAB+ with a suitable radio and radio becomes a glanceable experience as well as an audio one,” he writes in a blog post. “Crucially: this doesn’t change radio from a ‘secondary medium’ — something you can enjoy while you do something else. This isn’t crap TV. This is radio that you can glance at to discover what’s playing; what’s up next; and other pieces of information from broadcasters.” SLS, he explains, works on DAB or DAB+ by broadcasting the images along with the audio. “More usually this is known as DAB Slideshow, or visual radio.” Cridland thinks the idea is “slowly taking off” in Australia. He notes that stations in the United Kingdom are doing something similar. In the United States, HD Radio proponents have been experimenting with visuals under the Artist Experience initiative.

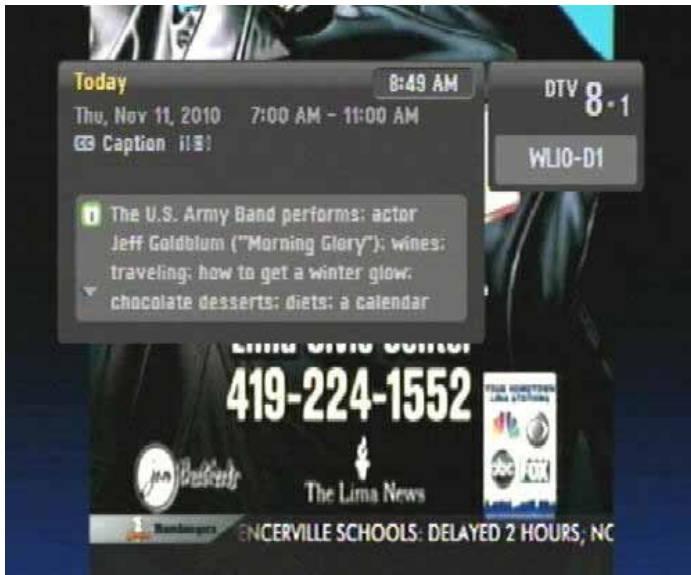

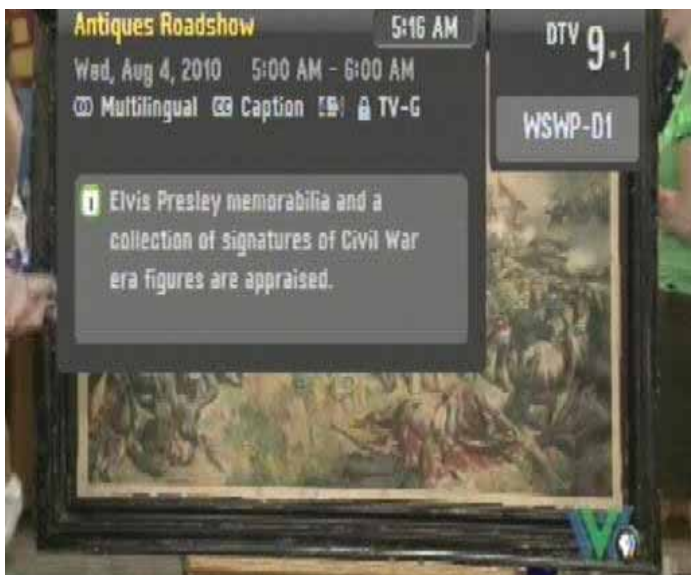

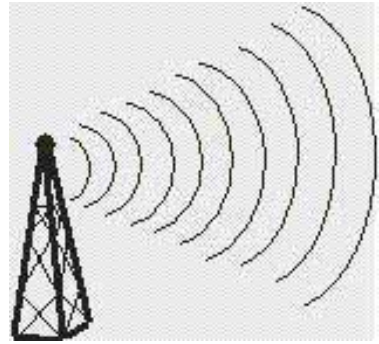
