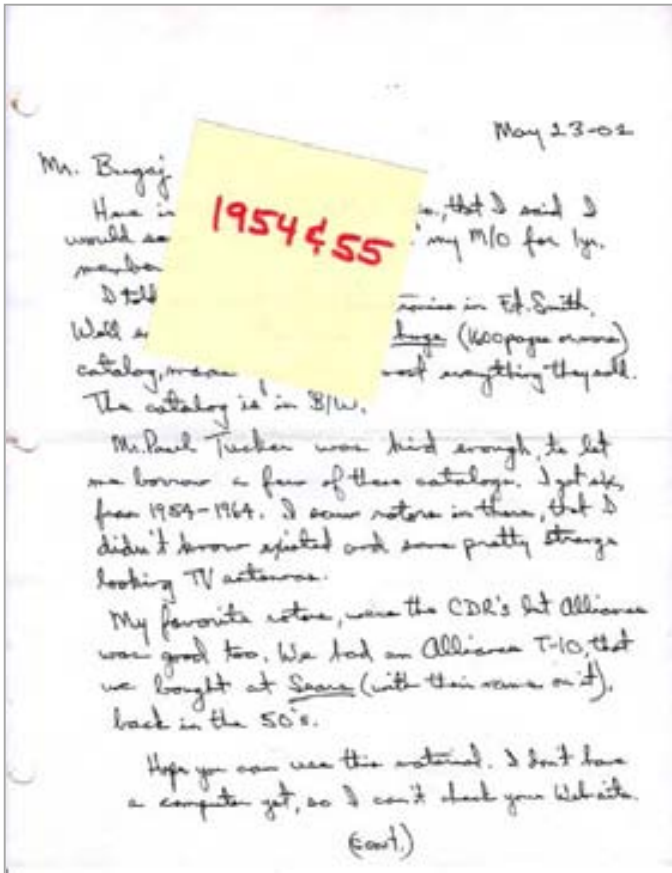

A few of you are familiar with a website called DX world. The creator of that site was a ham by the name of Bob Colyard. Some WTFDAers are familiar with the tvfmdxskiplog, which is part of DX World and a bulletin board for real time DX chat and loggings. Recently, Bob passed away, leaving that site in limbo. His wife has vowed to take the site down in July unless a competent person comes forth to take it over. At this point (June 22), no one knows its fate.

Also I would like a little time to tell you of the passing of

WTFDA member Gary Hickerson. Gary was an old timer (like me, I guess) who served in the navy during the Vietnam War era (like me). Gary was completely “into” antennas. When I began publishing the VUD he sent me binders full of antenna spec sheets and more, from various distributors in the Midwest and east. He occasionally sent me emails from Channel Master regarding new antennas, amps, etc. When Gary renewed a few months back, he enclosed a short note which said that he had spent much of 2017 in the hospital. According to Gary, the VA had diagnosed him with cancer and had given him chemo, only to operate on him later only to find out that they had mis-diagnosed him. I suggested to him that he sue the pants off of the VA. Then, a month or so ago, I heard from one of his friends via Facebook that Gary had passed away. I’ll miss him. He was a contributor to the WTFDA Forums and I know they will miss him there. The picture on the left is from May 2002 when Gary sent me a binder full of antenna specs and articles and distributor info which you can see dates from 1954 and 1955. I still have that binder. You’ve seen some of the articles in the VUD over the years also.

SKIP! After a totally useless June that made many want to throw in the towel, skip came alive in June with some great openings on FM, analog TV and even the weather band. The best opening so far was on June20th, which was so strong that it was nearly impossible to DX due to interference between stations. Ex-member Steve Walko reported two instances of double hop FM Es when he wrote “FYI, Nick Langan had 2x from NJ to Phoenix AZ on 91.5 on Tuesday and at the same time I had 2x from EPA to Tucson AZ on 93.7 (2:30 PM). And of course yesterday was likely one of the best wide area eastern US opening in 5 years.” Some are saying it was the best in ten years or more. I recorded about three hours of it with my RSP1 and SDR Console. I’ve only checked about 10% of it so far. I hope none of you missed it!! And by the way, Steve may be back.

THE WTFDA BOARD OF DIRECTORS is pleased to announce the addition of Jim Thomas to the board, making him our fourth member. Jim has unbridled enthusiasm for the WTFDA and our kinds of DXing. UPCOMING METEOR SHOWERS

Alpha Capricornids

Active from July 11th to August 10th , 2018

The Alpha Capricornids are active from July 11 through August with a "plateau-like" maximum centered on July 29. This shower is not very strong and rarely produces in excess of five shower members per hour. What is notable about this shower is the number of bright fireballs produced during its activity period. This shower is seen equally well on either side of the equator.

Radiant: 20:28 -10.2° - **ZHR:** 5 - **Velocity:** 15 miles/sec (slow - 24km/sec) - **Parent Object:** 169P/NEAT

Perseids

Active from July 13th to August 26th , 2018

The Perseids are the most popular meteor shower as they peak on warm August nights as seen from the northern hemisphere. The Perseids are active from July 13 to August 26. They reach a strong maximum on August 12 or 13, depending on the year. Normal rates seen from rural locations range from 50-75 shower members per hour at maximum. The Perseids are particles released from comet 109P/Swift-Tuttle during its numerous returns to the inner solar system. They are called Perseids since the radiant (the area of the sky where the meteors seem to originate) is located near the prominent constellation of Perseus the hero when at maximum activity.

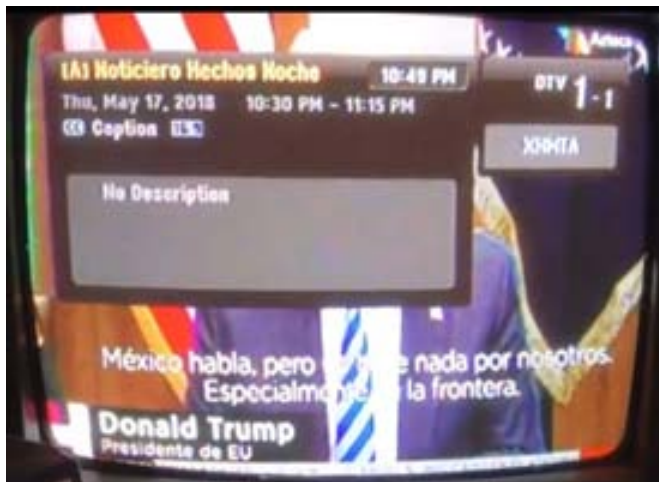

RTC station can now be found at 89.1fm

AS OF Friday (June 1) radio listeners can find all three Radio Turks and Caicos (RTC) stations under one FM dial - 89.1.

The announcement was made on Wednesday (May 30) by RTC director Christopher Jarrett and his team.

RTC is moving away from the three frequencies of 101.9, 103.9 and 107.7fm as the public has known it for the last 30 years.

All three frequencies will be converted to one frequency on the FM band in order to rectify its current reception deficiencies and make it easier for listeners across the TCI to hear the station whenever they commute across the TCI.



Minister of Home Affairs and Communications, Hon Vaden Williams commented on the change, stating: "We have seen many changes and over time RTC has changed from an AM frequency to three frequencies and will continue to be on the FM band, while we will reserve an AM band for a national radio service for the foreseeable future, should hazards or climate change affect our islands."

He also addressed industry speculation that RTC radio is now located in Providenciales.

"We are happy to confirm that a sub-office and studio is located in Downtown Provo, where shows are broadcast from and other businesses conducted," Williams disclosed.

Meanwhile, the board's decision to change the frequency reportedly corresponds with telecommunications decisions made at Cabinet and which will be announced at a later date.

"The change to one frequency is certainly a boost for the population of the TCI, as more residents and listeners use a variety of ways to listen to the station and therefore, with adjustments to lifestyle, we made the necessary adjustments.

"89.1 put us ahead as the Government's station as we continue to educate and inform as well as entertain," RTC director Jarrett said.

He added that residents in the sister islands will now hear RTC on the same frequency, without having to guess where the station is located on the band.

"To this day, many still believe that 107, 103 and 101 was island-wide, when in fact these frequencies represented one island within the chain," he said.

The change to 89.1 will be executed in phases over the course of one day - Grand Turk will be first in making the switch, followed by South Caicos, Middle Caicos and Providenciales, in that order.

Other broadcasters desirous of bidding for the old frequencies, will have to wait two months after the switch, due to changes made to the licence plan.

RTC will also be launching a Radio 2, to be announced at a later date.

Chairman of the RTC board, Ryan Walkin stated that the change in the frequency of the existing RTC opens up additional services in order to avoid potential interference from the high power national Dominican stations, which sometimes bleed into the TCI.

Deputy director of RTC, Lynette Thomas also added that the team at RTC and previous boards discussed what has now led to the designing of the new logo for RTC.

The new logo comprises of the change to FM 89, new emails, new URL, and will be added to the website next week.

Thomas added the logo signifies the coverage of RTC across the TCI with the colours of the country beautifully captured for all to see the new RTC.

She ended by saying that in addition to a second arm, a much bigger secret will be revealed soon.

RTC on the new 89.1fm band, is touted as creating a bigger and brighter future for the oldest station in the TCI.

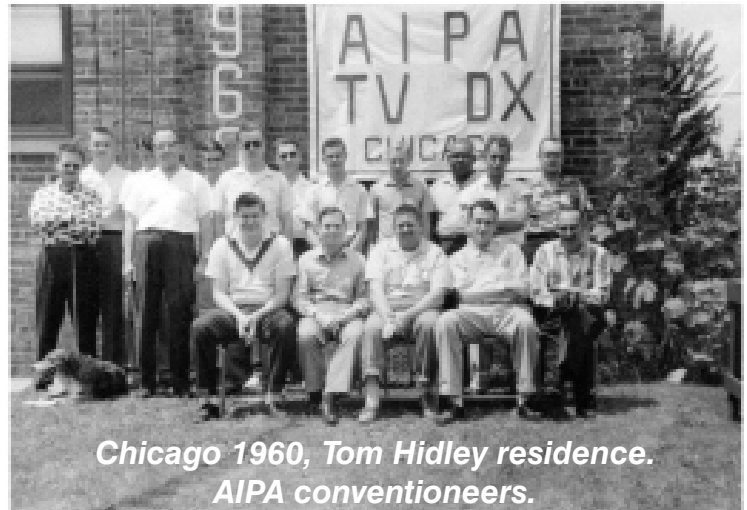

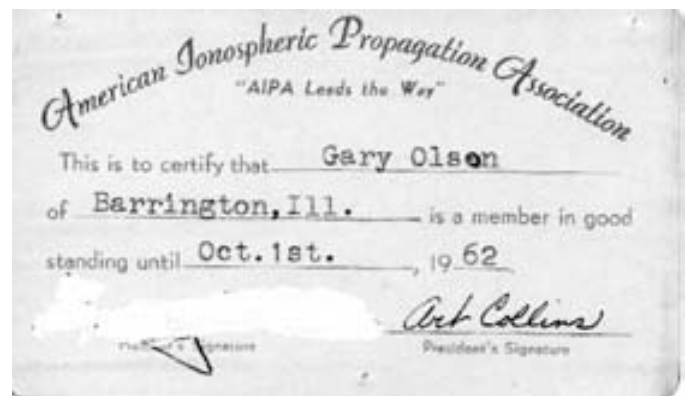
I noted in a recent VUD a note from David Hans on; I know Dave and Don exchanged communications frequently. When I went away to college I could only DX during the summer at home but my interest continued.

Unfortunately the AIPA went away as several of its leaders passed on. I moved to Milwaukee after getting married just as Ferdinand Dombrowski was contacting old AIPA members trying to put together a new DX club. Ferdie and I started the VHF UHF Digest using a mimeograph machine in his Milwaukee apartment and from time to time Dave Janowiak, Bruce Elving (who was working at University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee), Morrie Goldman, and other folks such as Roger Brown from Michigan and Roger Winsor from Indiana also joined us on occasion. Morrie and I had been corresponding while I was in college and he became an integral part of putting the new club together.

During my time in Milwaukee we located many of the former AIPA members and they joined WTFDA. I moved back to Chicago and brought the mimeograph machine back to my new home in Deerfield, which was about 20 miles north of downtown Chicago. Each month various members would come to my house to perform the extremely messy, dirty job of running hundreds of pages on the mimeograph to create the monthly bulletin. One day Morrie Goldman called and said he figured out an easier and better way to do the bulletin – offset printing. That significant decision made a superb change to the way we produced the VUD but we still manually had to do the stamps, address labels, etc., and get the materials to the printer prior to mailing. I subsequently moved to a larger home in Lake Forest and put up a tower. With Dave Janowiak's guidance I put up a 24 foot tower and later expanded it to 40 feet. All of the area TV DXers had large antennas on the roof and when we needed help to raise a tower or rewire a system several of us would get together to help get the job done. As time went on my employment changed and I was forced to travel a great deal. The rest of the local guys were pulled away from the group aspect and although we remained very involved with DXing our activity together became limited.

As the years passed I had less and less time for DX. I lost track of Don Ruland. Dave Janowiak built a special amp for me and we chatted from time to time. Morrie and I regularly communicated and made sure the bulletin got published but the handwriting was on the wall as we all had growing business and family responsibilities. Time marched on and Morrie got married and disappeared from the radar. Dave passed away before his time. At last contact Ferdie Dombrowski was still in a Milwaukee apartment. Bruce Elving passed away after running the FM Atlas for many years. In recent times my only contact with the TV DX past is via the VUD which I look forward to reading each month even though my antennas are gone and I do not scan the bands anymore.

I moved to Sarasota, Florida 20 years ago to escape the cold and snow. I reunited with my radio and TV interest serving on the board of WSLR 96.5 FM for many years and hosted talk, music and public affairs shows until recently.

During the years I was actively tuning the spectrum my most interesting catch was WRAY TV channel 52 in Princeton, Indiana, which was only on the air for one day. A winter trop opening brought in good reception for several hundred miles and I found a surprise station where none was expected. 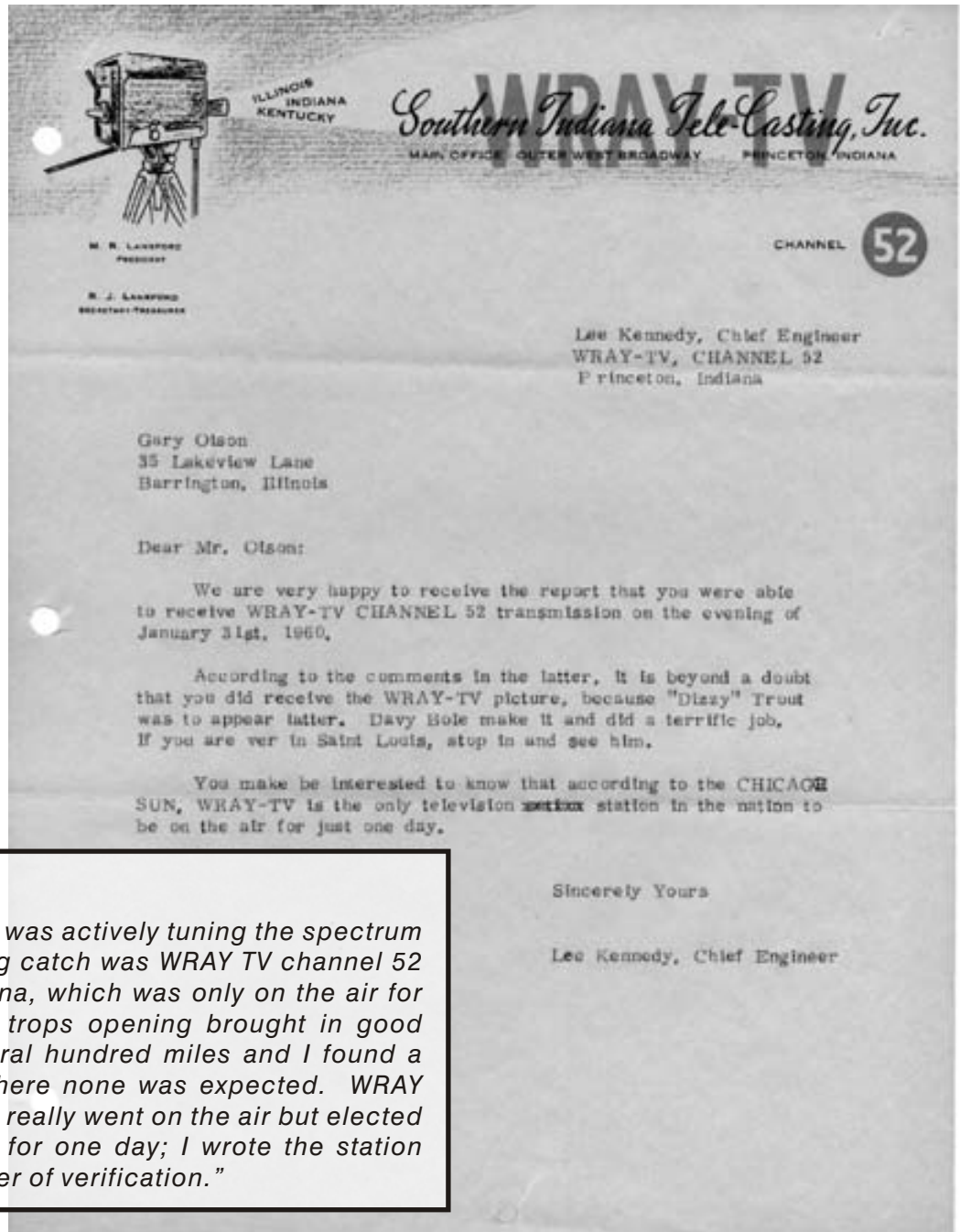
