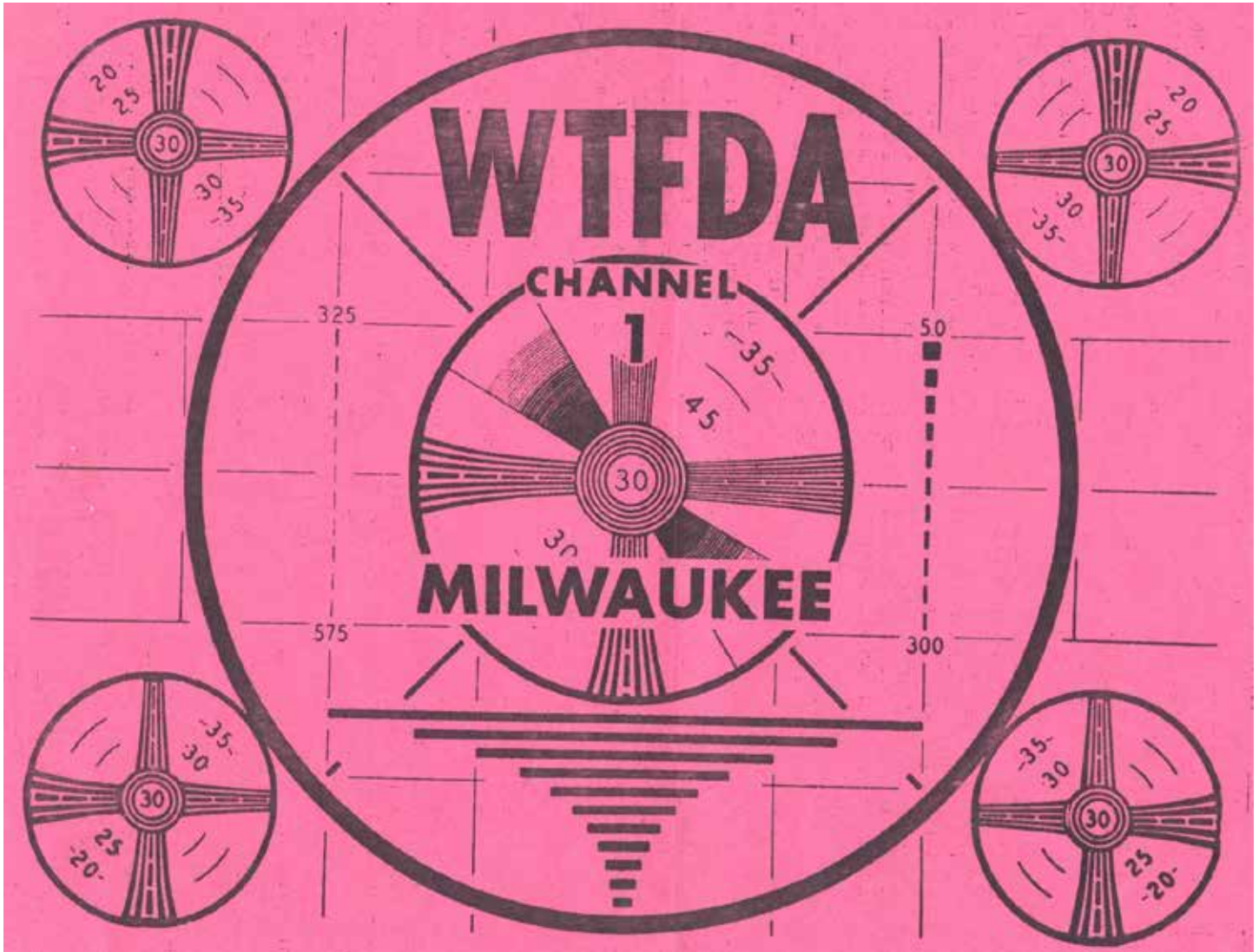

OLD VUDS SCANNED

One of the most fascinating things I find about the WTFDA is reading about how the club began, from a few TV DXers discouraged by the lack of TV and FM DX material available from the club they belonged to at the time, which was the successor to their first club, the AIPA, to what the club has become now. Thanks to new member Al Kopec, who in reality is one of the very early WTFDA members

from back when the WTFDA was known as the WTFDXA, we can now fill in some of the blanks in WTFDA history. Al has given us a good batch of old VUDs including some of the very rare mimeographed bulletins going all the way back to 1968 which I have scanned (thanks to Linux Mint and a neat program



called Simple Scan) and put up on the WTFDA website. If you go to www.wtfda.org and look at the left side of the page you should be able to find the VUD Archives. Look for 60s and 1970s VUDs and see what we now have. There are a few issues missing, so if anyone has any of those issues in a closet or a box somewhere, we could

use them. We will also take any old AIPA or WMRC bulletins you might have hidden away. So if you want to donate any, just be aware that they will be disassembled and cut in half for better scans and you won't get them back again. We'll also pay you back for postage if you want.

As a few of you know, I have a website (<http://www.mikesdx.com>). I keep it up mainly for my own entertainment and to play with css and html. have had to resort to radios d and cars to which we have put the outside antenna, my friend has put bifilar cable in the chanel yo no, I have laid coaxial cable RG-6U is the one that and could get these days, I will tell you that we have built almost all the small antennas of your site less 1 as big for lack of materials, but the only one that has worked us quite well and not on paper is the chanel master, on the other hand I will tell you that we have changed the measurements of the first dipole (the smallest) because the lower part of the band we see it loose not to that it's because of this, I know that antenna the biggest gain has it for the upper part of the band but well we're trying to get to a stability then I'm going to send you pictures of the receivers and the antennas I hope to be in touch I'm glad there are people who like e this hobby because the truth here is all internet and no one hears radio anymore, I'm sorry I can't write you in your language but thanks that there are translators haha

So here you have a guy in Santa Clara, Cuba building Probe 9s in a country where just about everything is in very short supply but he gets the job done. And then we have DXers in the US complaining about the lack of antennas but not even willing to try to build one even though supplies are available.

I guess I'll keep my website going.

The six 2020 LG OLED models earning the NEXTGEN TV logo from the Consumer Technology Association are: the 55-, 65- and 77-inch class GX Gallery Series 4K Ultra HD models, the 65-inch class WX Wallpaper 4K model and 77- and 88-inch class ZX Real 8K models.

The minimalist Gallery Series takes design to a new level with an ultra-thin form factor that hangs on the wall like a piece of art, while the razor-thin 65OLEDWX Wallpaper TV becomes one with the wall and includes a high-performance Dolby Atmos® soundbar for immersive audio. The 2020 LG OLED ZX Real 8K models, delivering four times more detail than 4K TV and 16 times more than HDTV, exceed CTA's strict requirements related to the official industry definition for 8K Ultra HD TVs.

Along with LG's proven third-generation ATSC 3.0 receiver/demodulator, the LG OLED NEXTGEN TVs include the new $\alpha 9$ (Alpha 9) Gen 3 AI Processor that leverages upgraded processing power and artificial intelligence to further enhance picture quality and enable specialized features for movies, games and sports. Combining OLED's self-emitting pixel technology and perfect blacks with support for Dolby Vision IQ and the UHD Alliance's new Filmmaker Mode,TM 2020 LG OLED TVs bring the cinema into the living room with new levels of realism.

They don't expect these stations to be receivable outside the speedway property. Of course, DXers may feel otherwise(grin). Chris Dunne has already tried from locations near two Miami-area facilities, without success. However, he wasn't trying at times the stadiums were occupied. I suspect he doesn't want to fight the traffic, and I suspect putting up an unusual antenna near the stadium during the Super Bowl would gather unwanted attention from police(grin).

I suspect the Washington HAAT figure is incorrect, as 32 meters below average terrain seems unlikely in that relatively flat city. Nothing in the applications explains why there are two stations at the same site in San Jose and Minneapolis.

The FCC has rescinded fines issued to three North Carolina FM stations for failing to file for license renewal on time. Stations are required to file for renewal 90 days before their license expires. (they are then allowed to continue to operate until the Commission acts on the renewal application, even if that action doesn't come until after the expiration date) Expiration dates are the same for all stations licensed to a given state. In the case of North Carolina, that's November 1st, 2019. (meaning renewals must be filed by August 1st)

One of the three stations showed that it had, in fact, filed its renewal on July 31st. They filed additional information (about the renewal announcements stations are required to make on the air) in October – and that was taken as the renewal date. The other two stations indeed did not file until after August 1st. However, both were new stations whose initial licenses were not issued until August 12th or September 11th. On August 1st, neither station *had* a license – they had nothing to renew.

Numerous Utah translators have moved to new channels. Where new powers, heights, or sites aren't given, they haven't changed from the old facility. In most cases the FCC has not yet issued call letters reflecting the new channel assignments. The Utah moves seem to have been completed in early January.

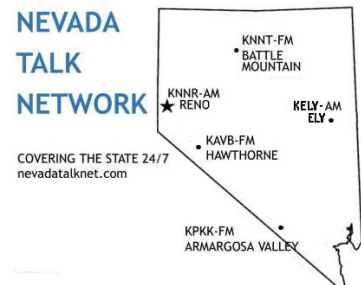

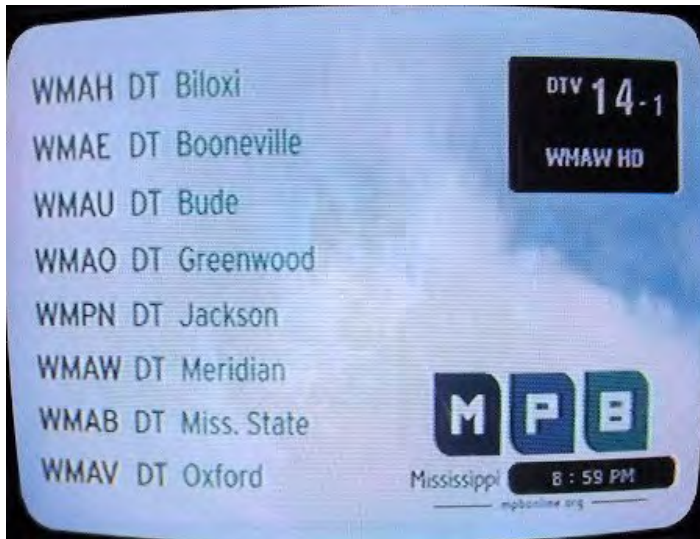

The first long-haul tropo opening I've had since August 2015 brought stations from western Kentucky, southern Missouri and western Tennessee, adding WIGH 88.7 and WMFS 92.9 to the logbook on September 14. The following night, several Central Illinois FM stations were taking out local translators. After checking into one of my local Ham Radio nets on September 17, I heard a mention of Fond du Lac on 162.5 MHz; a number of Chicago and Milwaukee FM stations made it in. The big surprise was WPNE 89.3 Green Bay taking out KTBJ. Several Michigan and Indiana FM stations were also heard, along with NOAA Weather Radio stations from Illinois, Indiana and Wisconsin. A new FM station signed on in November 2019 in KLUQ 93.3 Hermann, MO, simulcasting the Classic Rock format of KWUL 101.7 Elsberry, MO. This is a move from Steelville, MO, where it was Alternative Rock KNSX and later KQQX. Arkansas NOAA Weather Radio stations made it through on Christmas Day, along with short haul tropo from MO, IL and KY. 2019 wrapped up with the FM logbook at 1,337, and the NOAA Weather Radio logbook at 131.73 and good DX in 2020 from NOUIH, the Florissant Valley Dial Twister.

Lyrids

Next period of activity: April 16th, 2020 to April 30th, 2020

The Lyrids are a medium strength shower that usually produces good rates for three nights centered on the maximum. These meteors also usually lack persistent trains but can produce fireballs. These meteors are best seen from the northern hemisphere where the radiant is high in the sky at dawn. Activity from this shower can be seen from the southern hemisphere, but at a lower rate.

Next Peak - The Lyrids will next peak on the Apr 21-22, 2020 night. On this night, the moon will be 1% full.
