Internet: Old TV caused village broadband outages for 18 months

Switching off the problem television fixed the issue for Aberhosan villagers, Openreach says

The mystery of why an entire village lost its broadband every morning at 7am was solved when engineers discovered an old television was to blame. An unnamed householder in Aberhosan, Powys, was unaware the old set would emit a signal which would interfere with the entire village's broadband. After 18 months engineers began an investigation after a cable replacement programme failed to fix the issue. The embarrassed householder promised not to use the television again. The village now has a stable broadband signal.

Openreach engineers were baffled by the continuous problem and it wasn't until they used a monitoring device that they found the fault. The householder would switch their TV set on at 7am every morning - and electrical interference emitted by their second-hand television was affecting the broadband signal. The owner, who does not want to be identified, was "mortified" to find out their old TV was causing the problem, according to Openreach. "They immediately agreed to switch it off and not use it again," said engineer Michael Jones.

Engineers walked around the village with a monitor called a spectrum analyser to try to find any "electrical noise" to help pinpoint the problem. "At 7am, like clockwork, it happened," said Mr Jones. "Our device picked

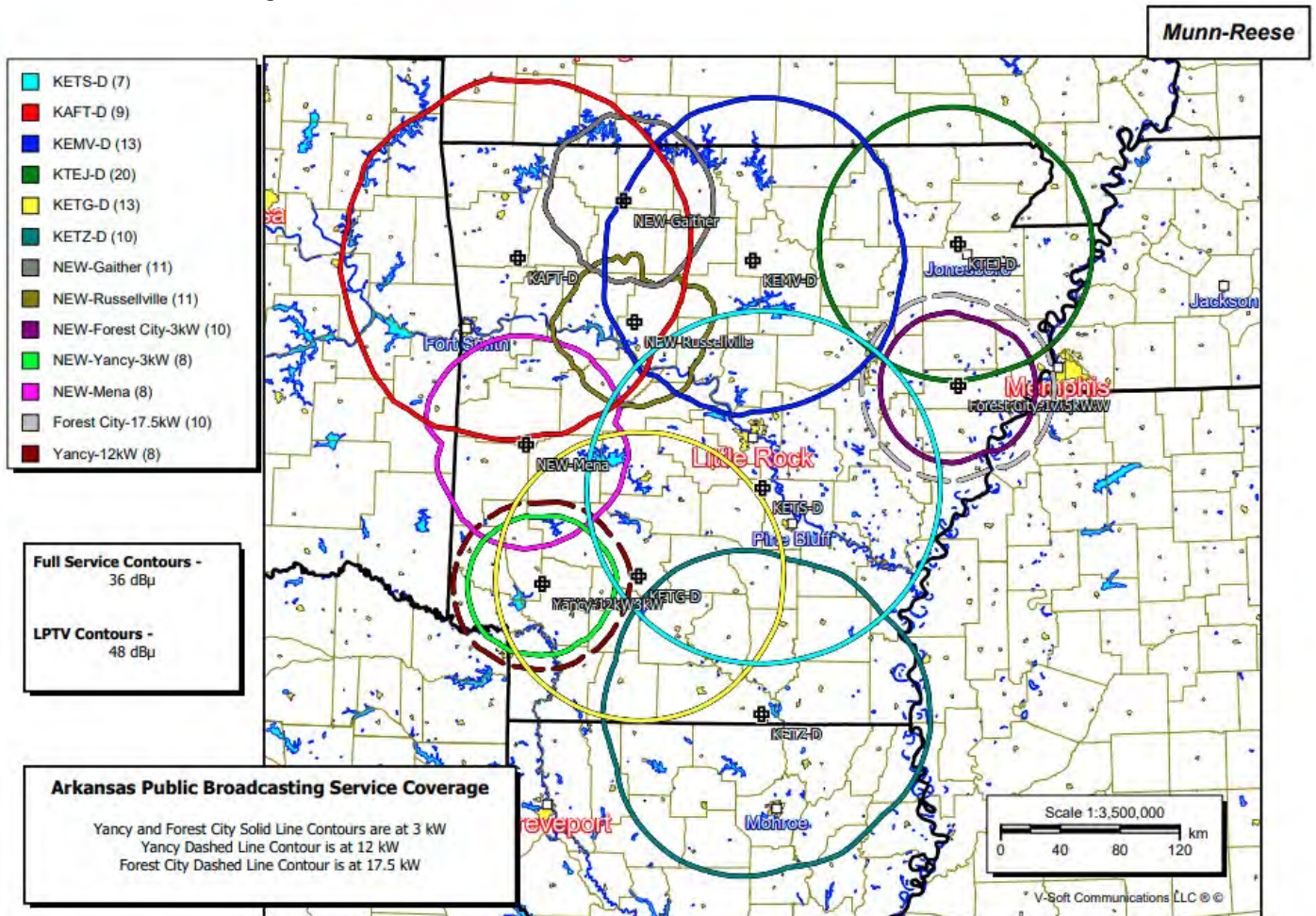

ARKANSAS ETV:

The Arkansas Educational Television Network (AETN) has requested five VHF LPTV stations to fill gaps in the area reached by their full-power stations. The filing says they cannot wait for the normal filing process as they're using federal CARES Act (coronavirus relief) money, which must be spent by the end of the year. With many Arkansas schools relying on at-home learning, the state argues they need to fill out their coverage.



ION: MAJOR PROGRAMMING CHANGES COMING:

The E. W. Scripps Company has, with help from Berkshire Hathaway, purchased the ION television network and 39 of its owned-and-operated stations. 23 ION stations will be sold – a buyer has been identified but not disclosed. The 23 stations will continue to be ION affiliates.

Scripps owns sixty TV stations spread around the country. These stations are affiliated with all major networks and a few of the smaller ones. It also owns Katz Networks, which operate five “subchannel networks” - *Bounce TV*, *Court TV*, *Court TV Mystery*, *Grit*, and *Laff*.

The press release says Scripps will move these subchannel networks onto the subchannels of the ION stations as affiliation contracts with other stations expire. Networks that would be displaced are *qubo*, *ION Plus*, *QVC*, *HSN*, and an infomercial channel sometimes known as *ION Shop*. The move will also leave programming gaps on those stations which used to carry one of the Katz Networks

channels.

“LOW-MOTION TELEVISION”:

The Canadian Radio-Television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC) has proposed to change the regulatory scheme applicable to “low-motion” TV services. “Low-motion” includes channels which broadcast only a series of stills; it also includes channels on which a camera is pointed at an everyday event and not moved. Examples include *The Fireplace Channel* and *Aquarium*.

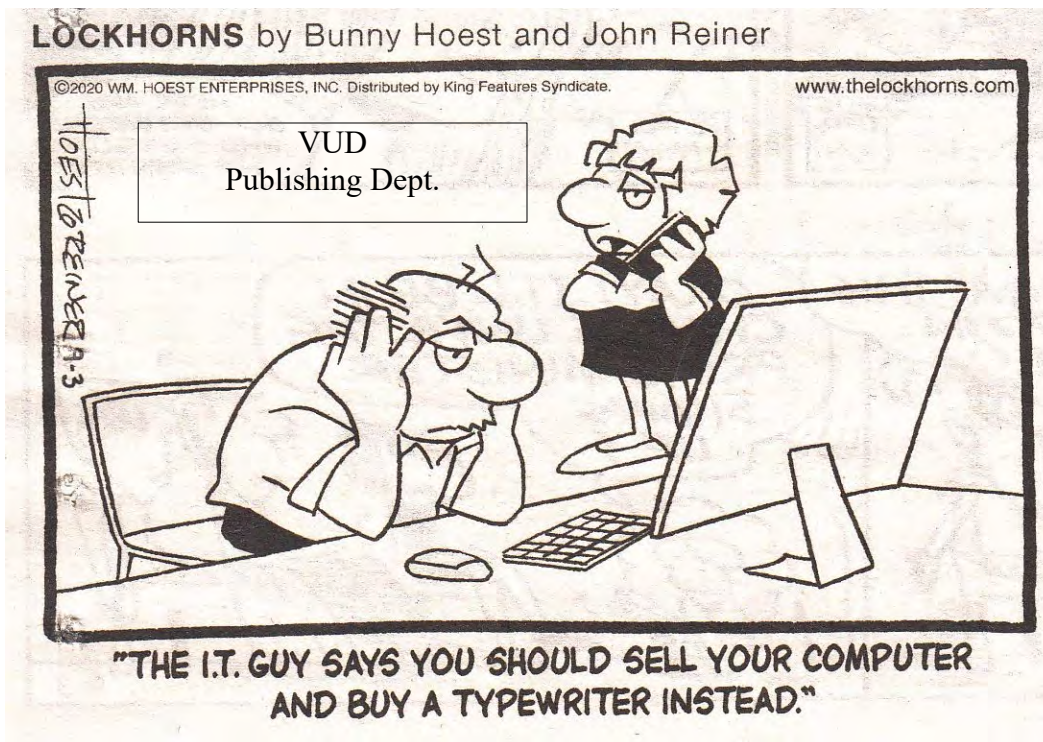
On the one hand, cable TV firms and the companies that provide channels to be carried are much more tightly regulated than in the U.S.. On the other hand, in Canada these are often the *same* company. (in the U.S., the owners of CNN, Fox News, ESPN, HBO, etc. don’t own any cable systems. In Canada, the owners of similar channels *do* often own systems.)

A Canadian cable operator carrying one channel they own must carry one channel they *don’t* own. “Low-motion” channels don’t count. On the other hand, sometimes low-motion channels are run by firms that *don’t* have any cable systems. These firms benefit from the 1:1 ratio of owned-to-independent channels rule.

NOT GONNA BE GRANTED:

An application has been filed for Special Temporary Authority for a TV station in Washington, D.C.. Applicant is (or claims to be) the U.S. Space Force. They wish to use 100kw/69m on channel 51, with the antenna located on an oil rig at coordinates that plot to... the South Lawn of the White House.

There is one applicant, well-known to those who read the FCC applications for filing these strange (and wholly ungrantable) applications. She is *not* responsible for this Washington application. Either way, don’t be bothering to scan channel 51. These applications are summarily dismissed as not suitable for filing.

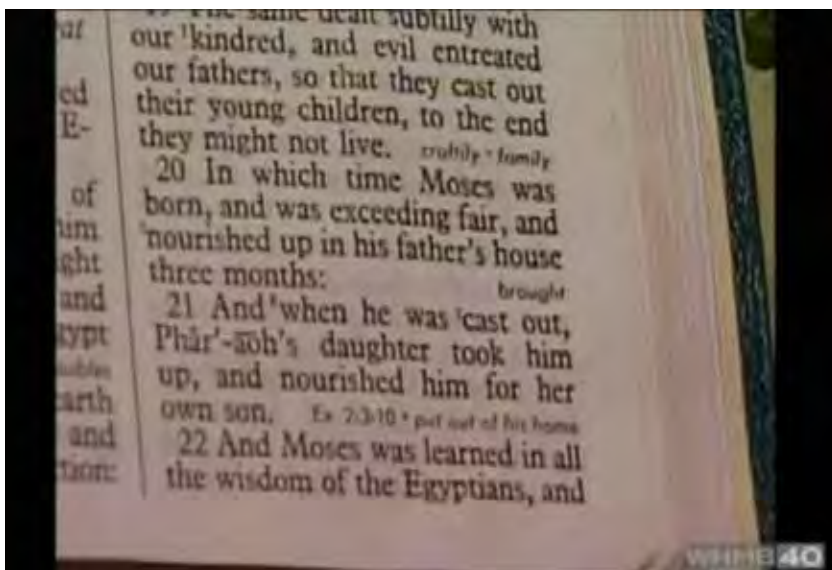

Before the format switch, Springfield had three Country music stations, so one had to go. WFMB 104.5 is long established in the format; WLFZ 101.9 has only been doing Country for a few years. I wasn't surprised that WUSW would be the one to dump Country music. So far, the tropo has been disappointing, after a dud of an E-skip season. 73 and good DX from the Florissant Valley Dial Twister.

The WTFDA propagation bulletin board could be routinely seen filled with blue, be it on the 5th (MO to GA DTV reported), the 7th (NY to NC DTV reported), the major enhancement across the I-95 eastern corridor on the 9th, KY to MN DTV on the 15th, and a significant opening from the Midwest to the east coast on the 16th, including a number of DTV decodes to OH, MI, and IN from Chris Lucas in NY and Scott Levitt in PA. Long-haul tropo also developed on the 26th and 27th across the Midwest and plains, with Ed Phelps in Kentucky logging KPNE-DT-9 North Platte at 739 mi. (congrats to Ed as well for his 1000th DTV log!)

** OKLAHOMA. July 13 at 1455 UT, level-5 tropo blob centred around OKC per Hepburn prediction, lesser rings out to the fringe here. Bandscan with broken antenna gets many Bad signals on the few open channels, including 6, presumably KBSD Ensign = Dodge City KS. And some of the OKC channels are not decoding, RF 27 & 29, obviously due to DX QRM, and even our local Enid K17JN-D translator invisible.

RF 20, 19-1 KQCW `News on 6` Tulsa market's CW is the only clear decoder, as it often is, but no subchannels on it.

RF 23, KSBI OKC is normally marginal or not decoding with its inferior tower/power situation, but now it's boosted so I explore its lineup: 52-1 KSBI; 52-2 Bounce; 52-3 Laff; 52-4 Grit; 52-5 Mystery. These match rabbitears.info listings, but W9WI.com does not show any beyond 52-1 (Glenn Hauser, OK, WOR)

** U S A. Level 1-2 tropo William Hepburn forecast around this part of OK, KS, July 17 at 1500 UT, and I bandscan starting at 1525: most open UHF channels, 20-36 have at least a Bad signal and several of the OKC channels are not decoding due to DX QRM. Also RF ch 6 Bad despite no apropos antenna, presumed KBSD Ensign=Dodge City KS.

A few do decode so I explore their subs:

** OKLAHOMA. RF20, July 30 at 1533 UT, regional tropo enhancement showed a Bad signal only on this open channel earlier, so I stayed on it and by now has visiblized with stable Dr Oz show on KQCW-HD Tulsa market; no subchannels. This is the one most likely to decode with any enhancement. OKC RF 27 KFOR is blocked by DX as is RF 17 3ABN translator in Enid (Glenn Hauser, OK, WOR)

** CANADA. 61.26 MHz, August 12 from before 0300 UT, this site <http://www.livemeteors.com/> is live-monitoring frequency for meteor-scatter pings at the annual peak of the Perseid shower; explains that from the Wash DC area a yagi is aimed at Timmins, Ontario, where there still exists a full-power analog TV station, on channel A3, video offset-plus, i.e. 100 kW CITO-TV per W9WI.com. I have indeed heard a few pings in a few minutes. It also warns that prolonged pings would be something else, and from 0405 I am getting some of those which I suspect are MS-induced sporadic E probably from same station. It seems that on the KiwiSDR roster there are NONE tuning the FM band, or any VHF from 30 to 108 MHz. Chris Mackerell in NZ explains that those SDRs are not designed to do so. A check of our northern sky found it clear for a change but too much Enid light pollution and mosquitoes to watch it very long. 73, (Glenn Hauser, OK, WOR)

** U S A. RF-31, Aug 8 around 1500 UT, minor tropo boost from Kansas allows KDCU Derby (Wichita) to decode briefly with infomercial in Spanish, after having spotted Bad signals on 8 and 10 likely also Wichita into my broken UHF/VHF antenna (Glenn Hauser, Enid OK, WOR)

** OKLAHOMA. RF 20, Sept 3 at 0345 UT a UHF/VHF bandscan prompted by minor area tropo of levels 3-2-1 between here and OKC, per Bill

Hepburn`s maps does get something: a mostly solid signal on RF 20 into my still broken antenna, from DTV 42-1 KBZC-LD. A rare glimpse of an ``Enid`` TV station, in Enid! Axually, Enid is only the community of license, why? while the transmitter site is the NE OKC Antenna Farm along with all the major TV and many FM stations, just south of the Kilpatrick Turnpike, per rabbitears.info, 7.2 kW ERP at 328 feet above ground. Approx. 100 km from Enid. Has 7 channels, all with same PSIP ID: KBZC-LD. First I survey the content of each channel, then compare to r-e listings:

42-1, commercials, but is Quest, logo circle-Q in lower right, 0400 reality show Ice Road Truckers
42-2, infomercials, no bug
42-3, BUZZR, bug LR, game shows
42-4, GetTV, bug LR showing part-time
42-5, infomercials, no bug; but at 0400, `Bonanza`, whence??
42-6, infomercials, no bug
42-7, ShopLC - formerly Liquidation Channel
This is one of those DTV America outlets providing a minimum of real programming, certainly nothing new or informative.

RF 21, at 0358 UT Sept 3, slightly weaker bad signal starts to decode while a top-of-screen streamer IDs as ch 19, KUOT. Listed as 5 channels of 3ABN stuff, 15 kW ERP from much further, the SE corner of OKC, near SE 95th and Bryant (Glenn Hauser, Enid, WOR)

** OKLAHOMA [and non]. Area tropo levels 1-2 and barely 3 over northern OK per Hepburn maps predicted for 1500 UT September 13, so UHF/VHF bandscan via my still-broken antenna from 1507 finds the following situation, by RF channels only:

Missouri joined the 40-DTV station club on August 17 with the log of KBSI 36; Illinois and Indiana are the other two states from where I've logged 40 or more DTV stations. In fact, I only need to log one more DTV from the Land of Lincoln to hit 50 DTV stations. The DTV logbook now sits at 195 stations. 73 and good DX from the Florissant Valley Dial Twister.

up a large burst of electrical interference in the village. "It turned out that at 7am every morning the occupant would switch on their old TV which would, in turn, knock out broadband for the entire village."

The TV was found to be emitting a single high-level impulse noise (SHINE), which causes electrical interference in other devices. Mr Jones said the problem has not returned since the fault was identified.

Suzanne Rutherford, Openreach chief engineer's lead for Wales, said anything with electric components - from outdoor lights to microwaves - can potentially have an impact on broadband connections. "We'd just advise the public to make sure that their electric appliances are properly certified and meet current British standards," she said. "And if you have a fault, report it to your service provider in the first instance so that we can investigate." (Thank you Paul Mitschler for the link to the article).
