PLP's - tiered reception

For those who may not know about how ATSC 3.0 reception works; the digital data can be divided into PLP's (Physical Layer Pipes). Each PLP can contain 1 or more subchannels. During reception it is possible that only some and not all of the PLP's will decode depending on the signal strength. The lowest-numbered PLP will have the lowest bitrate. The highest-numbered PLP will have the highest bitrate.

So PLP0 is the easiest to decode with a weak signal. With a stronger signal, PLP0 and PLP1 will decode. If there's a PLP2, then PLP0, PLP1 + PLP2 will decode with an even stronger signal, and so on. (4 PLP's is the max allowed, so PLP0 up to PLP3).

Here's an example with WNYO-16. The green boxes show examples of different numbers of PLP's decoding depending on the signal. In WNYO's case, PLP0 has WNYO, PLP1 has WUTV, and PLP2 has WGRZ, WIVB + WKBW.

## ANALOG: WHAT WON'T BE LEFT:

On March 4<sup>th</sup>, the FCC released a reminder to LPTV and TV translator stations. Analog TV in the United States will come to an end on July 13<sup>th</sup>. On that date, analog operations must be terminated, regardless of the operational status of any authorized digital facilities.

Stations holding Digital Companion Channels (DCC) must choose, by July 13<sup>th</sup>, to either shut down their analog channel and operate only the DCC; or shut down the DCC and switch their old analog channel to digital operation. For example, note this month WMUR-LP, analog channel 29 in Littleton, New Hampshire, has filed for a Digital Companion Channel on channel 25. Assuming it's granted & constructed, on July 13<sup>th</sup> the station must either convert channel 29 to digital & shut down channel 25; or shut down channel 29 and operate only channel 25.

(One could reasonably infer they would not build a new channel 25 facility in March only to shut it down four months later)

Stations choosing not to convert must surrender their licenses for cancellation on the 13<sup>th</sup>. All pending analog applications will be dismissed on that date, and all unbuilt analog construction permits canceled.

The Commission is recommending any last-minute technical changes to digital permits be filed by May 1<sup>st</sup>. This is not a legally-binding date, but the Commission is not sure their staff will be able to process applications filed after May 1<sup>st</sup> in time to make the July 13<sup>th</sup> deadline. If an application is not processed in time, a station may have to suspend operations until that processing can take place.

July 13<sup>th</sup> is also the deadline for "Digital-to-Digital Replacement Translators". These are translators constructed by full-power stations to recover digital service area lost to interference in the repack.

## CHANNEL CHANGE SCORECARD:

After the repack was completed, the FCC accepted applications from full-power stations wishing to change channels. Full-power stations must operate on channels allotted to their communities, so a channel change is a three-step process:

- 1) Petition the FCC to assign a different channel to their principal community.
- 2) Apply for permission to move their transmitter from the old channel to the new one.
- 3) Build the new facility.
