What is this?

This is the WTFDA's new newsletter. This newsletter will be delivered to you on the months that the full VUD is not published.

Why?

Basically, for two reasons. The first is that we have a large list of FM changes, both facility and slogan/format data, that we don't want to keep here for two months and give you stale information. As it is, this info already becomes stale news rather quickly. We want you to have it as soon as possible. Keep In mind though, that the facility info is entered into our FM database the same day we get it from fcc.today, so if you really need it quick, check the FM database.

The second reason is that some Dxers are not happy if nothing is received in their inbox around the first of the month, and we don't want any of them panicking or jumping off bridges because nothing was in their inbox. This solves that problem.

In addition, in case that the club has information to send you that can't wait 60 days to get to you, this is how we'll do it. This was reason #3. Darn.

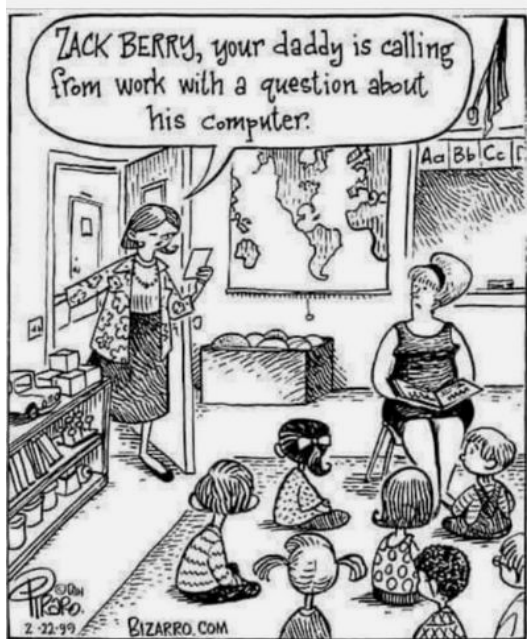
