An opportunity came along in the winter in the form of a new WTFDA website made with Wordpress. Jon and Nick and Bryce worked on it and got it online. I already had my own Wordpress website (mikesdx.con) online for some months although using a different theme then that of our new site, which uses the Divi theme. I began to play with Divi, and I really got into it, to the extent that the result of my playing is what you see at wtfda.org.

The next step was figuring out what I could do instead of the VUD. I didn't want to quit the VUD cold turkey and leave the club with nothing. So over the past month or two I created a home page for WTFDA members, a page you need to log into in order to view it. What's there now will replace the VUD. It will be the VHF-UHF Online Digest, and I just have to say it, it's pretty darn good, especially for someone who knew nothing about Wordpress prior to January first.

The DX columns will be there soon. FM changes, TV info will be there soon. Right now there are some FM antennas that are being given away FREE plus a 7' parabolic. There is also info on the major midwest tropo event that some people didn't even know about including a list of all receptions over 600 miles that I know of, and there were many, even approaching 1000 miles. It was amazing.

Even if you don't like logging into a website, you owe it to yourself to try this one. I know some may not be happy but that's the chance you take when you make a change. This one is a big one, but consider the alternative.

I would like to end the pdf VUD by the end of December, if not sooner. The VUD Online is live right now. If you would like to regiser, go to wtfda.org and look for "login" at the upper right corner of the page. Click it and then choose register and register yourself. To protect the site from spammers, please wait until we approve you before you can enter the site. It might take a while. **Don't be impatient or try registering again please!**

The Wordpress site should keep the club going for a long time to come. The great thing, in my opinion, is that there are people in the WTFDA more knowledgeabe with WP than me who could keep the thing going if I wasn't available to maintain it. But I'm not going anywhere, trust me, not yet and at least, not willingly. :-)



The season started with hearing some short distance tropo through my local LPFMs, translators and semi-local stations. On May 17, I noted that WNG728 on 162.425 MHz is now back on the air, moving from Bellflower (in Montgomery County) to Hawk Point (in Lincoln County). Another poor E-skip season is in the books here in Hazelwood. At least there's still tropo. Starting off this column: comments from Ryan Grabow.

This has been another fruitless E-skip season for me as a TV DXer. In the last 11 years of summer/winter monitoring, I've had two digital E-skip logs! Two! In 11 years!

Granted, I'm going to lose something for living in condos and apartments, but this is ridiculous. Mobile DXing isn't a good option with our summer heat and thunderstorms. Over the years, I've tried multiple tuners, monitoring three channels at once and even using a software-defined receiver (SDR) to watch for pilot carriers. Unplugging the router and other sources of QRM doesn't seem to help. I think of how easy it was in the analog days, even with a whip antenna.

At this point, TV DXing has become a 100% tropo hobby for me. I'm changing the maps on my Web site accordingly. The July 12 opening brought a new log in K18KK; I was surprised that the signal was stronger than main station KQFX-LD 30! The channel is configured similarly to the main station. The opening shifted to western KY after 0400, followed by western IN after 0450, then to Indianapolis after 0700. Logged WISH 9 for the first time since they swapped networks with WTTV. The short July 26 opening noted a switch in the channel for MeTV in Central IL; the Classic TV channel had been on WRSP 16.2 (55.2) and WCCU 36.2 (27.2); both stations have been switched to ATSC 3.0. Of the VHF to UHF DTV conversions in my region, only the mid-MO ones (KOMU 27 and KRCG 29) are complete. KHQA has yet to move from 7 to 22, WGEM yet to move from 10 to 19 and KFVS yet to move from 11 to 32 as of July 15. I have local LPs on 19 and 22 that are easy to null. As of August 1, the DTV log stands at 219.

The Saga of KRMF-LD

KRMF-LD 4 Reno, NV gtd silent STA 7/1/23

KRMF is requesting permission to temporarily go silent due to repairs needed on the Anywave PA unit. Due to its age and a separate incident with a past employee, we have experienced several hardware failures that necessitate shipping to Anywave for full repair. Our RMA# is TS2303-0575. After we receive the crate from Anywave for shipping, we hope to have it promptly returned and repaired as soon as possible. Below is the report from the engineer that has been handling the on site repairs as well as his images for reference:

"...This work includes identifying the power connector for the transmitter and ordering a functionally equivalent connector. This included buying parts from two different vendors. The power cord needed to be rebuilt as well, but the power connector on the wall end of the cable was able to be reused. In the process of doing the work, it was observed that the bottom of the transmitter was caved in. Two connectors on the back panel (in addition to the power connector) were damaged (These were repairable). And almost every screw I encountered was loose, especially screws associated with the basic structure of the amplifier. Some internal hardware had also vibrated loose and disappeared. A thorough inspection was required to ensure none of this hardware had gotten into areas with circuitry. Apparently, this hardware fell out through cabinet openings some time during shipping and reinstallation. When reinstalled in the rack, it was also evident that the front panel was also slightly caved in.

The two power supplies were clogged with dirt. They were opened and cleaned, as well as inspected for loose hardware. Nothing unusual was noted in this area.

The PA compartment was opened for inspection (56 screws!). Much to my surprise, I discovered that this amplifier has had a 'hot lunch'. If you look at the pictures of the PA pallets, you will see a big ferrite bead wound with litz wire. This is the input filter for the power to the RF devices (which are underneath the heat sink pillars, with the two screw holes in the end). You will see that the litz wire varies from very dark in color (most likely red, green or amber before 'cooking') to charred. I included two repeat views of the PA pallets with different lighting so you can get a better look. There is also a picture showing bits of the cable ties that held the ferrite bead to one of the coaxial cable phasing lines. You can see bits of a cable tie on one of the beads. I did not measure any shorts on the output side of the RF transistors or evidence of punch-through on the transistor input gates. As indicated in discussions with the Anywave tech, the low PA idiling current may be bias adjustment and not failed transistors. The abnormally low bias current (0.4 A) usually indicates failed transistors, but the absence of shorts or punch-through (input gate short) are encouraging signs things may not be as bad as they could be.

The burnt chokes are also still securely soldered down and not showing excessive resistance. You can see where the inside of the PA cover has discolored spots from the burnt chokes. On the input splitter and output combiner, there are some ballast and reject loads, in the form of the white squares visible in the pictures. These appear to be of the 'pass-through' type, and they measure a very low resistance between terminals, as expected. But every single one measures open circuit to ground. They should measure about 100 ohms, as indicated on the device labels. This is indicative of operating into a very awkward impedance load (or a short, or no load at all). The open loads on the input side is more mysterious, and rarely occurs. It is possible that if all

four PA pallets have failed catastrophically that the input loads could be damaged. It is also possible I am measuring these wrong, even though I double checked my measurements.

No other internal damage was noted, except for loose hardware found throughout the amplifier, especially on the major structural mountings. To me, this is indicative of severe, sustained vibration during shipping.

Both of the RF input connectors are damaged. One connector was dented. The other one looks like it had been ripped. I identified a replacement for these connectors, but they were \$56 each. So I repaired the existing connectors. Although they are not perfect, they work fine.

After full closeout and before rack mounting, the amplifier powered without incident. However, after installation, it would not pass a signal on either RF input. I was using the known-working channel 3 exciter, temporarily set to channel 4, to drive the amplifier. Input attenuators were set the same on both amplifiers, and setting attenuation to zero did not help...

WBNF-CD 15 Buffalo NY gtd silent STA 7/11/23

SOL owned station WNYZ-LD remains the only Next Gen TV station in the NYC market and as such SOL is aware of the lack of ATSC 3.0 capable TV sets, tuners and USB receiver sticks. A new budget is being developed for the implementation of the W09CZ CH 9 CP which will consider ATSC 3.0. 
