HAWAII WEATHER RADIO HEARD IN SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA. It hasbeenknown for some time now that under the proper conditions, a duct will form between the islands and the mainland that lets DXers in Hawaii hear FM radio stations from Central and Southern California and even the west coast of Mexico. A ham in Hawaii by the name of Sheldon Remington became famous for his FM tropo receptions to the west coast some years ago. Now we have proven tropo ducting from Hilo, Hawaii to Cambria, California (northwest of San Luis Obispo). We don't have the exact date but it appears to be in early September. We don't even have the name of the person who heard the station but we do have the video of the reception and <u>that video is here</u>.

Looking at a map of California, it's possible that an FM DXer could possibly log some Hawiian FMs there via ducting. For one thing, Cambria probably does not suffer from band congestion like the San Francisco and Los Angeles areas do. There are hills not far from the beach that would allow a DXer to climb up or down a hillside into a duct. The width and height of a duct could vary and moving up or down a few feet on a hill could make or break a reception. I wonder if our weather radio DXer tried FM?



SDR SOFTWARE. Here is a post from our FMDX-NA group on groups.io about what is the best software around for DXing FM with an SDR. Bill Nollman writes:

The ELAD GUI (FDM-S2) is still my favorite for recording and most playback. Except for recording failing from time to time (has been fixed many times since the beta days but...) I just like the look and it feels like I can see DX no matter how small. With SDR-Console I never feel like the display is as accurate or sensitive as FDM-S2, Yes, you can adjust contrast, colors, pallet, zoom but again it just never feels as good as SW2. Many others would disagree with me.

And then there is SDR-Console. For years I downloaded it, installed it and hated it. Almost every time I couldn't get it to be on frequency, I'd click somewhere and the frequency would get off by some annoying offset. If it wasn't that, it was that I couldn't get audio out of it no matter what I tried. Then came the RDS Autologger. So I downloaded SDR-C again and was blown away by what it could do. The first test was on a DXpedition to Cappahayden, NL. You can <u>see the map here</u>. everything east was logged with SDR-C and the autologger script. Just amazing! then I discovered the RDS decoding was often superior to SW2 or even RDS Spy! So SDR-Console has been used often to decode RDS only. So while it's still not my day to day SDR software, it does things that the others can't.

THE TOWER CLIMBER. This item was submitted by Tim McVey. It's about a guy who rode up with an engineer to the top of a 2,000 foot tower in North Carolina and wrote about the experience. You might find this interesting. I've had to copy it from its original source and the photos were quite large so the formatting is not perfect but the photos are pretty interesting. The journalist should be commended for his bravery.

ASYMMETRICAL SIDEBANDS. The FCC has given the green light for HD radio stations to use different ERPs on upper and lower sideband to help with interference to adjacent analog transmissions. The only channels exempt from this ruling are 107.1 through 107.9 because the FCC wants to protect air communications. <u>You can read about it here.</u>

KFVS CHANNEL 11. On May 17, 2021, the Bureau granted a petition for rulemaking submitted by Gray to substitute channel 32 for channel 11 at Cape Girardeau for KFVS-TV. Gray was also granted a construction permit to construct a facility on channel 32 at Cape Girardeau, but was unable to complete construction of the channel facility by the expiration date – June 23, 2024. Thus, Gray requests amendment of the Table of TV Allotments to allow it to continue to operate pursuant to the parameters of its current license on channel 11. The substitution of channel 11 for channel 32 in the TV Table of Allotments will allow the Station to remain on the air and continue to provide service to viewers within its service area. (The KFVS petition was granted).

ANOTHER NEW TEF WEBSERVER! Today (9/29) I noticed another new TEF webserver online. This time it's in Wilmington, NC. If it stays on, it will be the sixth TEF webserver in the United States. All of the other webservers are run by WTFDA members. I wonder who started this one? <u>Here is the new link</u> for all TEF webservers in use.

Wilmington NC seems to be a great place to stick a webserver. Think of the tropo possibilities, even if the radio uses only a dipole as an antenna.

DOMINICAN REPUBLIC TV A-D CONVERSION This was supposed to happen in July but as far as we know, it didn't. According to Jim Thomas, finding any information online about the conversion isn't easy, but he did come up with a chart that shows two digital stations approved for channel two and another for channel four. I guess we will just have to wait for the 2025 skip season to find out, providing it's a better skip season than this year was.

Sinclair Communications will flip AAA "<u>The Coast</u>" 850 WTAR Norfolk and translators 96.5 W243EK Hampton and 96.5 W243DJ Norfolk VA to Conservative Talk "**Talkradio 96.5/850**" on Monday, September 16.

Commonwealth Broadcasting flipped Classic Rock "**107.3 The Point**" WRZI Hodgenville/Elizabethtown KY to Variety Hits "<u>107.3 Jack-FM</u>" over the holiday weekend. (9/4)

Audacy has flipped Soft AC "94.1 The Sound" KSWD Seattle to Hot AC "Emma 94.1".

Advanced Media Partners in Peoria has cleared the blank space that was 96.5 WHPI Farmington and 104.3 W282BS Dunlap/WPIA-HD2 to launch "<u>Tay Radio 96.5/104.3</u>" (all Taylor Swift)
