

Primarily a TV DXer, Donald's equipment includes a Zenith Transoceanic 7000, a Tele-funkun AM-FM portable, and two Motorola TVs, one a B&W 9" portable and the other an 18" color portable.

RICHARD S. BRUNDAGE is a postal clerk who enjoys monitoring railroad calls with his Radio Shack pocket scanner.

Bruce Elving's FM Atlas is the place where RICHARD W. HILL found out about WTFDA. His gear includes a McIntosh MR-78 FM tuner, two stacked nine-element Channel Master FM yagis fifteen feet high and a rotor. Richard partakes of a rather expensive aspect of the hobby- calling many of the DX stations he hears.

The DX shack of JAMES E. LAWHEAD features a Hammarlund HQ140X, a Zenith TV, and a Panasonic FM. James is a machine operator who enjoys DXing all bands.

The FM setup of DONALD NELSON consists of a Kenwood 7001 tuner, a Sansui 777A amp, stacked Finny FM4's 31' above ground, and a C.D. 22 rotor. As far as TV goes, Donald has a Channel Master 1110 antenna 31' above ground topped off with an 8 bay stacked bow tie and an Alliance V-100 rotor. Donald is seeking advice on the types of filters that can be used in FM receivers.

Tidbits.....

Dave Egan recently installed a new antenna system at his new address. His equipment includes a 68' tower, a Zenith rotor #867-1005, a 7' Channel Master UHF dish #4251A, and two VHF "Jets". San Francisco member Harvey B. Woodworth is interested primarily in TV-FM DX, but the current economic situation is hampering his efforts to upgrade his equipment. Harvey's gear includes two Zenith products, a Trans Oceanic for shortwave and a 17" B&W TV, both hooked into a Panasonic 7412 AM-FM multiplex tuner so that better audio from the receivers can be comfortably monitored through the stereo headphone jack on the Panasonic receiver. Until he can upgrade his FM-TV equipment, Harvey will be devoting his DX time to BCB and shortwave.

Rich Eddie of St. Louis would like to receive member's suggestions on the best types of outdoor FM antennas and rotors to buy. MICROWAVE TV-DX?

As many TV-DXers may have noticed, there is now an increasing use of television at microwave frequencies (mostly in the 2500 MHz band). Applications include the following:

Private Channel TV -- Local transmission of educational, religious, news bulletins, video art to pay TV broadcasts. Pay TV broadcasts are scrambled.

Satellite down links -- Signals from such high power satellites as ATS-6 and the Canadian ANUK penetrate many areas. More of similar design are sure to follow.

Broadcast links -- For studio to transmitter applications, or remote site to studio. Usually much higher in frequency and using very directive antennas.

All this points up to a possible new horizon for TV-DXers. Surprisingly, many microwave systems do not use highly directive antennas for transmission, and should be receivable over a wide area. One new microwave pay TV company is advertising a 35 mile range. Microwave signals are also affected by tropo and ducting however, making DX a real possibility. Unfortunately, many video microwave systems use FM modulation for video as well as audio, making it impractical to use a simple converter with a standard TV receiver. What is needed is a complete receiver which has a video output signal. In the past two years, the cost of semiconductors for microwaves has greatly been reduced. In theory, it could be possible for a lowcost video microwave receiver to be constructed (either by a manufacturer or a scratch builder). The problem is finding a DXer with microwave experience that could make a prototype unit. Are they any microwave design engineers in the house?

Exciting things are being done with computers, and I'm now better able to organize members' reports as they come in. Most of them are summarized above, leaving mainly miscellaneous remarks for this section. More about computers later, but now...

To receive WGGL's slow-scan TV picture it takes a \$4,000 signal expander made by Colorado Video Corp.; the special FM-transmitted pictures will initially be picked up only by various CATV systems in upper Michigan and retransmitted. WWJ-FM 97.1 Detroit changes format somewhat to "music in touch with today." It is said to be Detroit's most popular FM and third among local AM and FM stations. WNUF 100.7 New Kensington PA continues playing big band records in \$, although part of their record library was destroyed by a fire. WGMS-FM 103.5 Washington DC had a major fire, but most of records (classical) escaped destruction. WQXI-FM 94.1 Smyrna-Atlanta GA has a telemetry SCA sounding "like a pure tone with bird chirps superimposed on it, which is quite startling when heard for the first time." But not all SCA-telemetry stations have any distinctive signal, so I will continue to leave them out of the Atlas, but will be referring to them in the FCC-FM Column.

North Pole AK, where an FM's been applied for, is about 15 mi. SE Fairbanks, with the town of College (home of KUAC *104.7) four miles west. XHPL Ciudad Acuna still on old frequency (98.5; supposed to go to 99.7; all other Mexican stations are believed to have switched). However, on a recent skip outbreak XHPL alone among three Mexican-received stations announced with call letters; the others with slogans. It takes much more space to list slogans than calls, so I wish pressure could be put on these stations to use their call letters, too!

Cedar Rapids' KCKK"-FM" *88.3 is on the air 6 am to midnight 365 days a year. KOYE Laredo TX still on 92.7, not yet having increased power and moving to 94.9. KEHG-FM Fosston MN's manager not concerned when called and told the station is on 107.7, instead of 107.1, and who knows if even the FCC would move against them and the other off frequency offenders? One correspondent wonders if WQXA York PA and WTKT Baltimore (licensed Catonsville) MD have directional antennas, since he measured the distance between them as only 50 miles! Both are on 105.7. Mystery: "WLBE" heard by a FL reporter during a skip opening to Ohio, etc., area on 99.9 [the WLBE call's used to be in Leesburg FL, but who knows where the calls are now?]

Paul Petrosky, Munising MI, plans to apply for a translator to cover the town of Grand Marais MI; the WQXO 98.3 signal sails right over the town, but not down where the folks live.

August 1975

WJPD-FM 92.3 Ishpeming MI not in stereo; they've had problems with their microwave to the transmitter, but are announcing (fraudently) as in stereo. KEZZ 94.3 Aitkin MN not in \$ for now; giving legal id's for W269AA 101.7 Grand Rapids, KEZZ's translator.

KMFE 101.7 Emmett ID has Intermountain Network news at times. Working at a commercial station, Bill Frahm saw skip on the TV monitor at KBOI Boise. "The switcher and I spent most of the morning of June 22 DXing. He missed several commercial breaks while trying to ID what turned out to be WCCO-TV 4 and KSTP-TV 5 in MN. I made him super an ID on ch. 2 every 15 min. during the opening so it would be easy to ID!" WNWS 97.1 New York now all-news, NN.

NBC has now begun its new NN (News and Information Service), affiliating several stations who will agree to carry only news and talk programs, including several FM's, none of which are expected to continue stereo. All-known NN FM affiliates have been listed in this section.

Andy Bolin, 709 Lincoln Ave., Charleston IL 61920, would like to hear from any "major" FM DXers interested in swapping taped copies of their best DX. He's now at 1475 FM stations heard!

Adding to information in the June VUD, WPRO-FM 92.3 Providence RI has been top-40 for a year now, \$; while WWON-FM 106.3 Woonsocket RI is automated beautiful music, \$. That writer wants me to make a distinction between so-called "beautiful music" and "middle-of-the-road" stations, both of which I classify as m. I don't care to, because the difference is more in the nature of presentation rather than between the types of music. The b station may have less announcing and more instrumentals, while the mor station may have announcing after every record, and have somewhat more vocals, but the difference as I see it is one of emphasis, not one of kind. Expected on the air this fall is WOTB 107.1 Middletown RI, \$. WKRG-FM 99.9 Mobile AL is Hit Parade, \$, carrying the CBS Mystery Theatre nightly at 7:05, Garner Ted Armstrong at 8:05. ABC-FM news usually, but CBS news late at night. On air or testing: KALU *90.7 Langston OK 10 watts heard.

KQRS-FM 92.5 Golden Valley MN conducts its special test with frequent id's after 1 a. m. CDT August 12 to coincide with the annual Perseids meteor scatter occurrence. Tropes may also be in. Send reports to Terry A. Stripsky, chief engineer, ZIP 55422. KXTC 92.3 Glendale AZ Latin jazz Sunday nights 10 to 2; their normal format is m. WQSR 102.5 Sarasota FL is lead for Tampa-St. Petersburg among adults 18-34 among all AM and FM stations, says Pulse and ARB.

Now, a word from your friendly computer service. FM data cards are now keypunched for all stations on the air and authorized in the US and Canada, as well as FM station applications! If you want the very latest information (updated to the day it is sent out) and more complete than in the Atlas (giving coverages, for example, to the 1000 and 50 microvolt/meter contours), then you might want a computer list for your state or region. These low rates are for WTFDA members, and are good through August 31. Entire deck (U. S. on air and authorized); about 4000 cards: \$8 + \$1 postage. One state or group of states (sorry, no partial states) or all of Canada: \$1 postpaid per state. Listing of applications — about 500 — \$2.50 postpaid (add .50 for Canada). Minimum order \$2.00 please. Applications do not show facilities change requests; just applications for new stations. Now, thanks to a June **Guia** forwarded by Ken Simon, we can unravel some of the mystery. You can now update your last list and/or the **TV Station Guide**! Net-8 has been cut back to but 3 relays: XHFM-2, XHP-3, XHTQ-9 (ex-net-5). Net-4 remains only on XEX-7, XHAL-10 and 12 in Huétamo, Mich. (prob. low power). Net-13 now exists, via many 11s, 12s, 13s; and 4s in Chihuahua and Yucatán (not Televisa); Changes in Net-2 include XEHL-6 (formerly on 2 in Guadalajara, with XEHL-L); on ch 5 in Cd. Guadalajara, Chih.; ch 6 in Cd. Delicias, Chih. (These last two could be translators); ch 14 in Mexicali, B.C. (and I've seen XHQ-5 as L). Net-5 takes over much of the old net-8: Aguascalientes-13, Acapulco-4, Cd. Victoria-13, Culiacán-13, Zamorano-5, Guadalajara-9, Hermosillo-10, Las Lajas-5, Los Mochis-12, Mazatlán-7, Monterrey-6, Parral-3, Saltillo-7, Tampico-9, Tepic-4, Torreón-2, Zacatecas-3. Also listed is Chihuahua-2, but I saw XHCH with L, announcing net-2 also, not net-5. Watch out for "Televisa y Vd." Mon-Fri 1:00-14:30 CST, when all four nets are in parallel!





"Because most Es are usually snowfree with rapid fade characteristics, I have stopped listing the signal quality. Where it is of minor concern to me it will probably be easier for you to omit the 5555 from each Es logging. Because tropo can and usually do have wide variations in signal quality, and it is indicative of the quality of the tropo opening, I will continue to list the signal quality of tropo signals.

VHF is still in poor shape from lightning strike; I would estimate about a 4-6db loss or its equivalent, in antenna gain. I replaced the 3 Blond & Tongue hybrid splitter combiners used to combine the array and it helped the signal, but I lost the deep nulls off the main antenna lobe. The Channel Master hybrid splitter used is the chief suspect. I re-connected the lossy setup with the 3 splitters to get the nulls back. Meanwhile, I am awaiting a good 4-way splitter-combiner from CACCO, what they use to combine antennas. I'm not totally convinced that the problem(signal loss) is in the combiner, but I can't get to the antennas. I've made 5 trips up and down the tower and each time it takes me about an hour to get over the shakes. I hope I can get this thing fixed soon, with minimum of climbing. I hope you fared better than I with tropo thru June. It was a let down!(Not much in the way of tropo up this way Jim. I can imagine your problem as I had similar ones and they're not easy to fix. Good luck with fixing your setup; I'm sure you're going to need it.--wd.)



Dear WTFDA Members:


As a fellow DXer, I would like to ask your assistance in a long-term project I recently began.

I am attempting to obtain photographs of the test patterns of television stations in the United States and Canada. You can help in this effort by photographing the test patterns of your local and semi-local stations, as well as those of any DX stations you might be receiving.

The purpose for this effort is to establish an all-inclusive test pattern guide which would be available to the DXer and which would aid in solving many test pattern unIDs. Such a guide would be particularly useful to the meteor scatter DXer, who is often confronted with brief glimpses of barely recognizable custom test patterns.

Before you go running for your camera, however, a few words of importance. If this is your first attempt at TV photography, remember not to use a flash; it will only blot out the TV picture with its own reflection. Try to fill the entire photograph with the test pattern, but beware: when at close angles, you may have to tilt the camera severely in order to center the pattern. WFTDA's Beyond Shortwave has some other helpful notes concerning TV photography. Incidentally, I would prefer that you use black and white film when taking these pictures, although color photos are acceptable if there is no alternative.

If one or more of your local stations uses unidentified color bars, you needn't bother photographing them; merely indicate in your letter the number of bars in the pattern (usually seven or eight). If the station uses unidentified three-fourths color bars, please describe these using the format (a-b-c), where "a" is the number of bars in the color bar section, "b" is the number of the bar under which the white square begins (for example, $2\frac{1}{2}$ if the square begins under the middle of the second bar), and "c" is the width of the white square in terms of the color bar width (1 for single bar width, 2 for double, and "1+" for any width in-between). For example, the pattern below would be classified (7- $2\frac{1}{2}$ -1+).



Please do send photographs of IDEd full or three-fourths color bars, however, as innumerable differences in ID placement, size of logo, etc. are in existence. There are also so many variations of supposed 'standard' patterns such as RETMA and SMPTE that I ask you to photograph these as well, whether IDEd or not. In addition, it would be most helpful if you would note the times at which each test pattern is aired (both on weekdays and weekends) on the back of each photograph, in your local time.

Here's your chance to utilize those DX-preventing locals for the betterment of DXing and the WFTDA. This is a project in which all members, from novice to veteran, can participate. 

However, July 13 flux was 88, the highest since last December. So, one still can not safely say just how close to the solar low point we are. These flux data are not corrected for the variable earth-sun distance (apx 91 million miles in January and 94 million in July) so the latest spurt of activity would cause even higher fluxes at other times of the year.

The Swiss and American sun spot counts for April reached the lowest averages since the bottom of the last cycle (Oct 1964). However, the smoothed averages are running relatively high yet.


